If you sell a product or provide a service (which includes farming or boarding animals), in the Borough, resulting in a net earnings of **\$12,000** or more in the tax year, then you are required to pay the annual Local Services Tax (LST) amount of **\$52**. This tax is enacted under the authority of Pennsylvania’s Local Tax Enabling Act, as amended by Act # 7 of 2007, and Mount Wolf Borough Ordinance (No. 2007-3). (Copy is available upon request.) An individual who is employed in the Borough and elsewhere shall be subject to payment of the LST amount first to their principal employer. If an individual meets the Borough’s taxing requirements and previously paid the LST elsewhere, they shall be required to pay to the Borough \$52 minus the amount of tax previously paid elsewhere for that tax year. The Tax Collector will give a receipt for this tax payment if a self-addressed stamped envelope is sent with the tax payment.

If paying no tax: you must return this form and check the reason:

1. No longer self-employed. [] 2. Net earnings in Borough will be less than \$12,000. [] 3. Tax of \$52 was previously paid. []

If claiming exempt, attach exemption form or proof of previous payment of LST for the current tax year.
