CONVENE

VISITORS

AGENDA

A Witmer/Dierdorff motion was made to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

MINUTES

TREASURER'S REPORT

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Adam Anderson presented the following:

- Georgia Pacific's Flood Plain Review went well.
- They are waiting on the Highway Occupancy Permit to begin working on the Center Street inlet.
- The trucking company will be contacted about the damage done to the Walnut Street bridge from the train accident in the early fall.
- The Main Street Bridge has rebar showing and should be repaired. They are also looking into fixing the sidewalk on the bridge in the spring. This work can be done separately from the bridge.
