

MT WOLF BOROUGH MINUTES

April 9, 2013

CONVENE

The Mount Wolf Borough Council met in a regular session on Tuesday, April 9, 2013 beginning at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Council President, Pat Poet.

ATTENDANCE

Council -- Don Dierdorff, Ted Fadely, Les Jordan, Bill Marquis, Dennis Naylor, Ronald Witmer, Pat Poet, Mayor Josh Bowers, and Secretary Steve Kehler were present. Attorney Joe Gothie arrived at 7:20.

AGENDA

A Marquis/Witmer motion was made to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was passed unanimously.

MINUTES

A Dierdorff/Witmer motion was made to approve the minutes from March 12, 2013 meeting. The motion was passed unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT

A Jordan/Marquis motion was made to approve the March 2013 Treasurer's Report and the 4/9/13 Payment of Bills -- #2052 - #2075. The motion was passed unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS

Steve Kehler did not have any communications to share this month.

VISITORS

- Dave Heckert is the new caretaker of the Mt. Wolf ball field. He wanted to update the council members on a few things. The hot water heater in the refreshment stand needed replaced. There was also some electrical work that had been done. He also inquired who supplies the paper towels and toilet paper for the bathrooms at the ball field. Since there are more teams playing on the field now, the rest rooms are going through more paper products. Dennis Naylor said he would help take care of that.
- Joe Stevens, along with 2 other gentlemen from the merger committee for the fire companies was present to give some updates on the merging process. He also wanted to let the council know that there was a merger meeting scheduled for April 16th at Eagle Fire Company.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

The Borough's new engineer, Christopher Owens, was present to introduce himself. He also said that the MS4 report was being reviewed and that they needed to revise DEP updates and name any tributary that has a discharge.

He also mentioned the bid reports for paving Walnut Street. Dennis said he would like to delay this project and work on filling pot holes instead.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

Joe Gothie reported that he received approval from the insurance company for the damage that was done to the Walnut Street bridge from the train accident.

PARKS & RECREATION

Don Dierdorff is still working on getting the plaques for the flag poles. Mulch is also needed for the park by Memorial Day.

STREETS

Dennis Naylor reported on the following:

- There are several areas in the Borough that need to be cut out from the curb to the street in order to be repaired. There are also quite a few potholes that need to be filled.
- The street sweeper will be making it's rounds the beginning of May.
- The sidewalk inspections should use the ordinance as an idea for what needs repaired. It should also be posted that Borough officials are walking around inspecting sidewalks so that the residents are made aware.

PROPERTY & SERVICES

There was no report.

INSURANCE

A letter was received from Selective Insurance informing the Borough that workers compensation was being cancelled. There was a misunderstanding with the completion of the audit. Bill will be in contact with the insurance company to take care of this matter.
